Collections

June service focus is the Clemmons Food Pantry.

Most needed items:

- Canned Meat (tuna, beef stew, chili with meat)
- Canned Fruit
- Bisquick/Biscuit Mix
- Dry White Rice
- Dry Beans (pinto, lima, black or northern)
- Canned Spaghetti Sauce
- 2 lb bags of Sugar or Flour
- Canned beans (pork & beans, black beans, refried beans)

There are some rules and recommendations about donating non-perishable food that we ask you to follow.

- We accept all non-perishable (not frozen or refrigerated), sealed, unexpired food.
- We accept unopened toiletries (shampoo, soap, shaving cream, etc.) that should be kept separate from any food donation.
- We prefer to receive non-glass containers for the safety of our volunteers.
- Baby food can be accepted, but only in plastic containers.
- Pet supplies and pet food cannot be accepted.

Thank you for your faithful support of these monthly collections. Bins are located outside of the Sanctuary to drop off your items.
